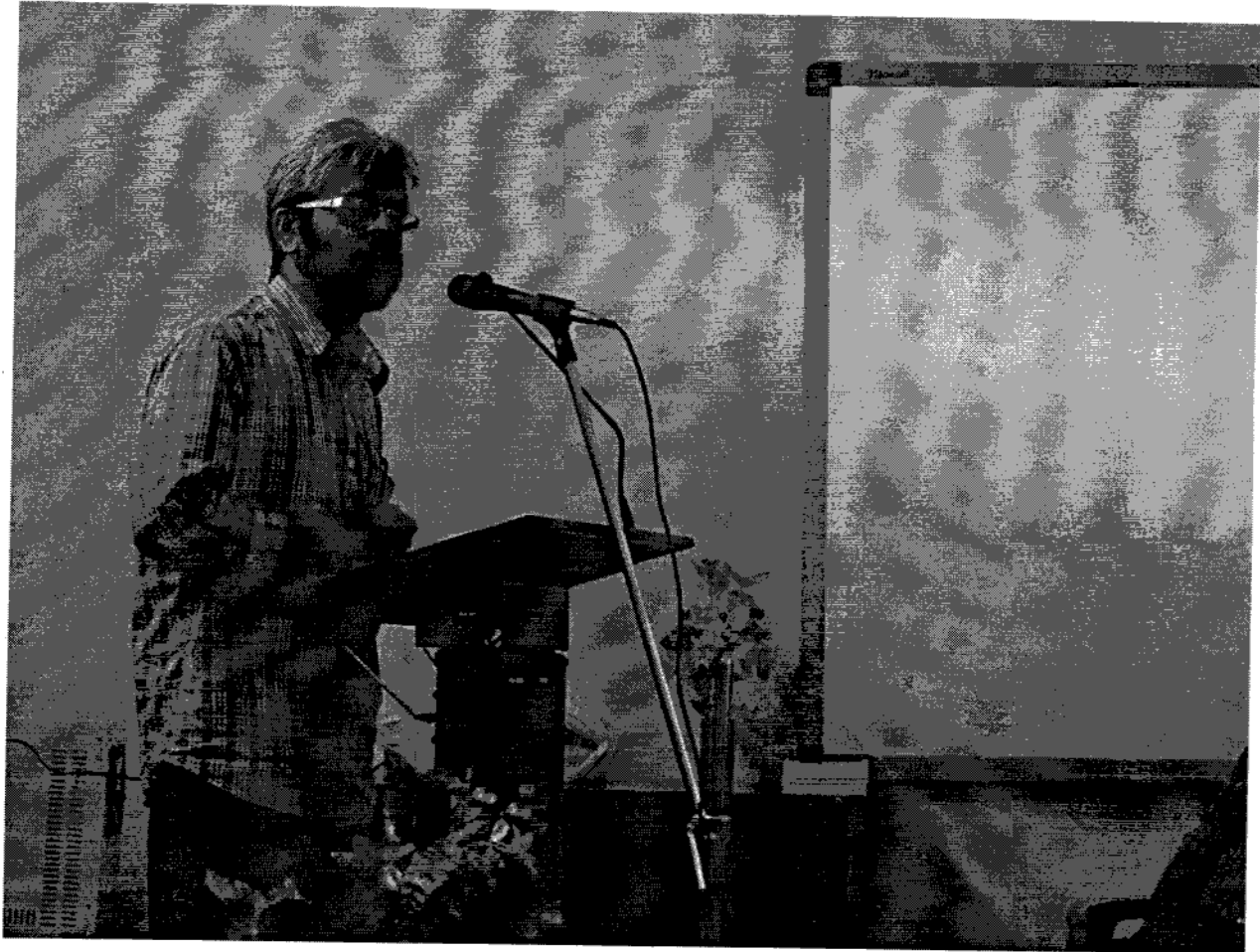

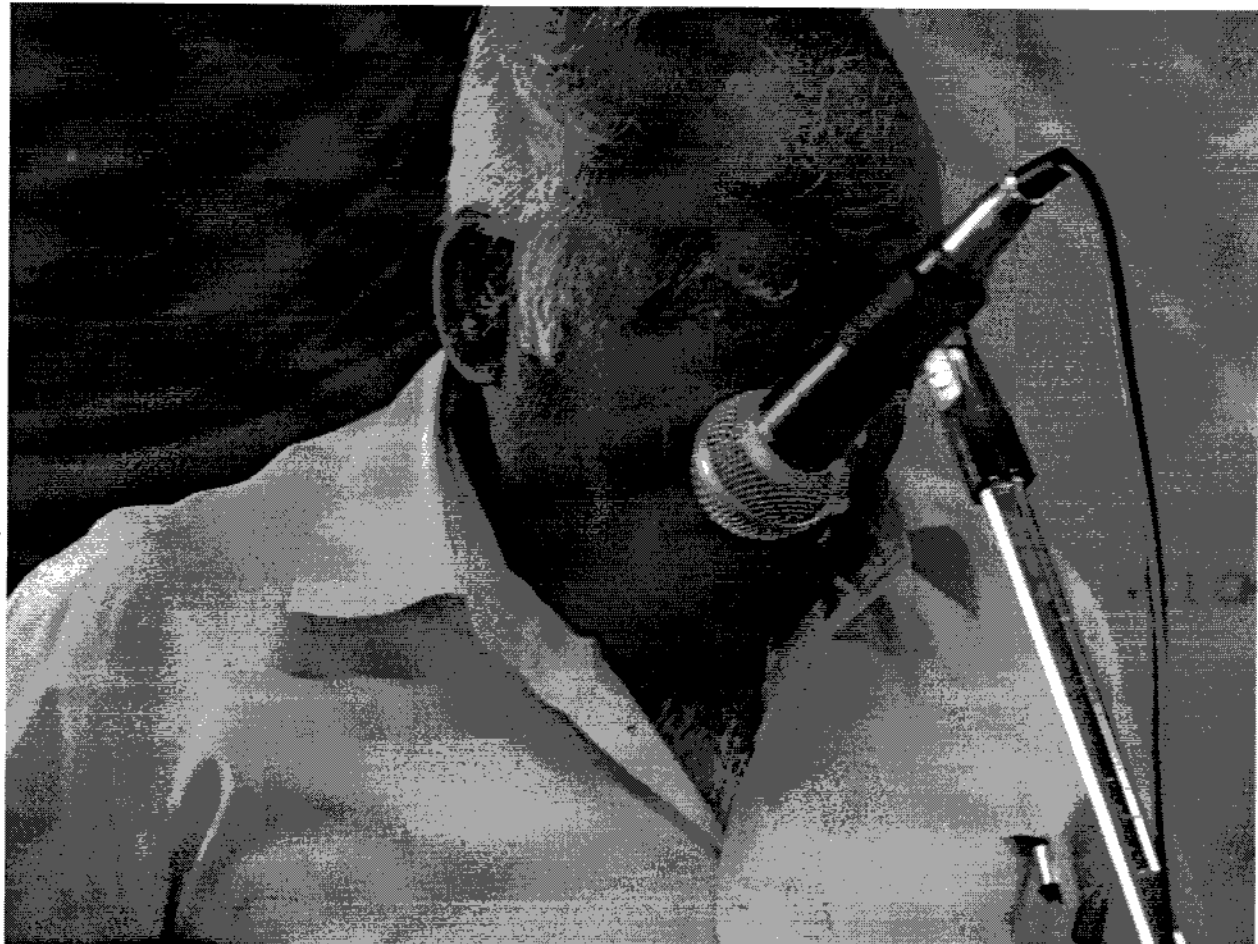
International Nelson Mandela day -21 July

There was a quiz competition for whole college UG students

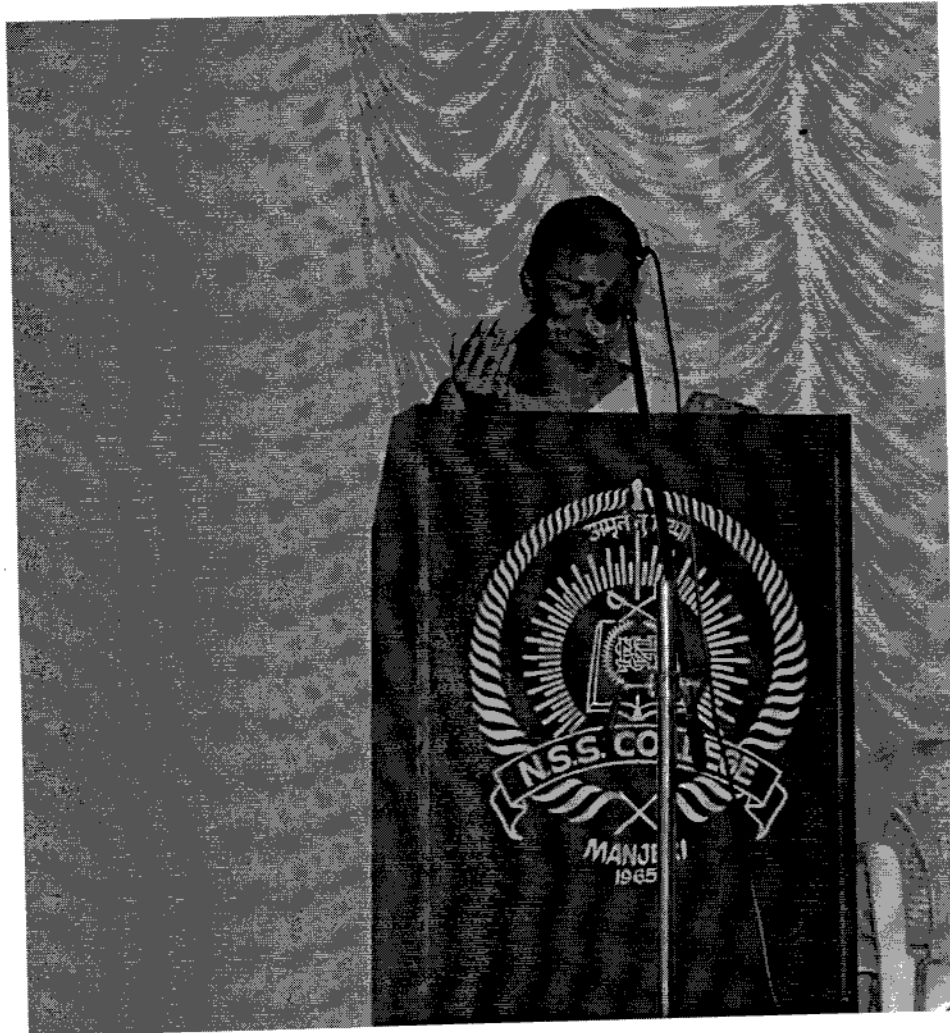
Teacher's day- September 5

Gandhi Jayanthi International peace day- October 2

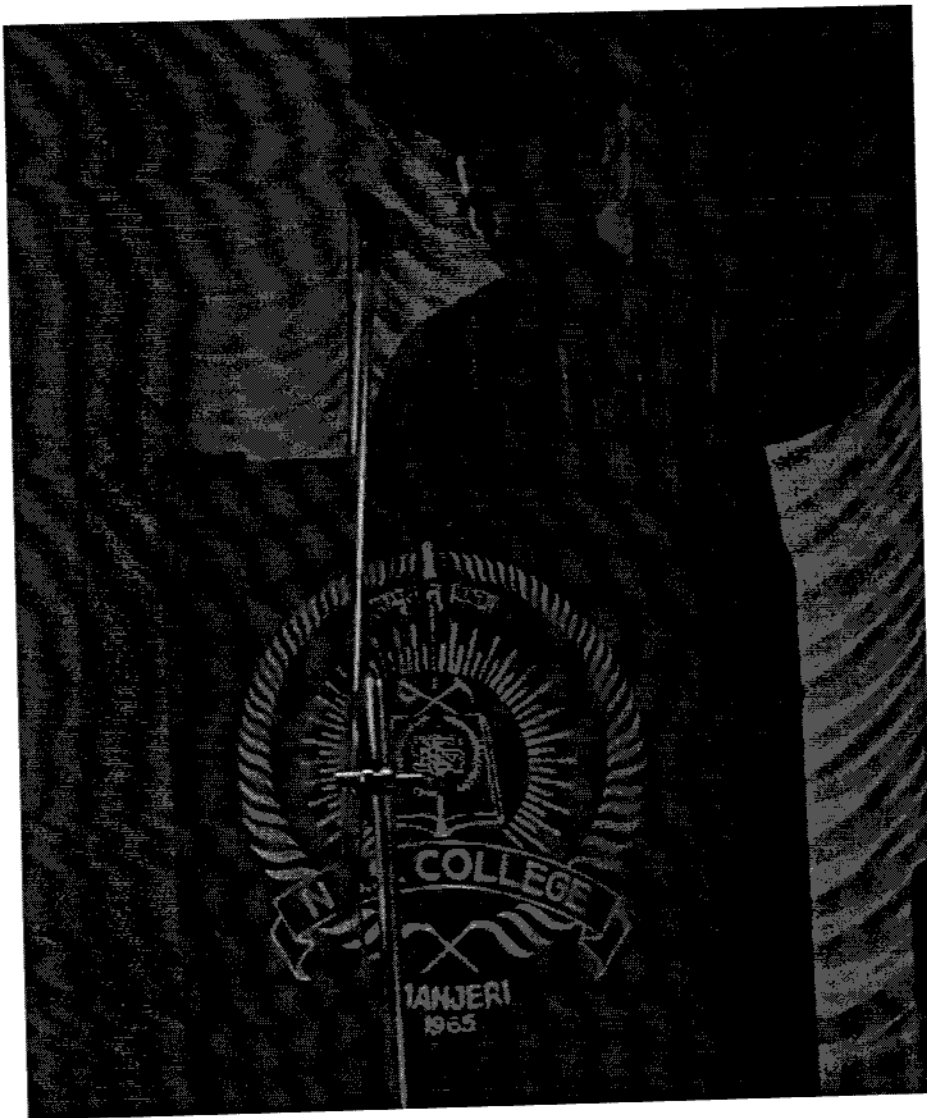
Sevanavaram programme starting, all students of the department took part in carrying out in cleaning the college premises.

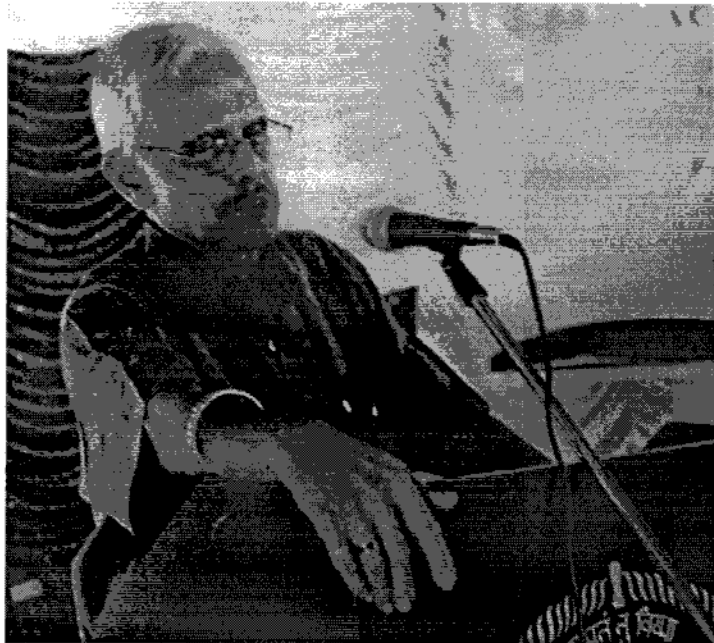
Quit India day- August 8

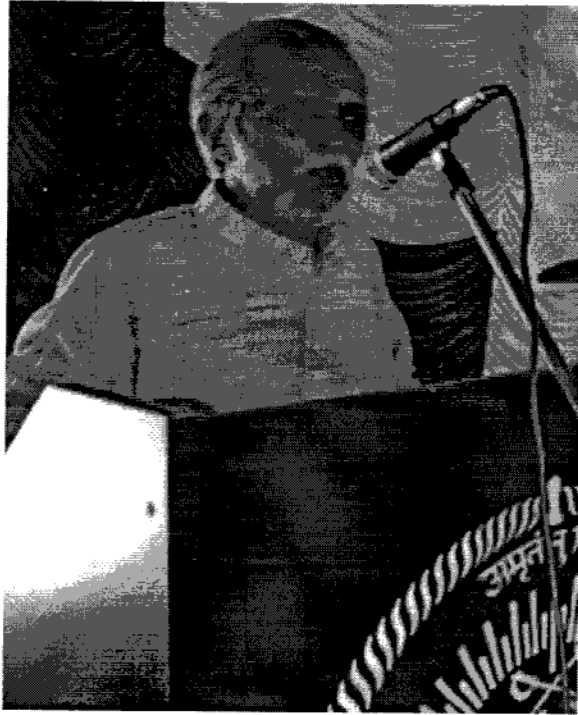
Gandhi Jayanthi International peace day- October 2

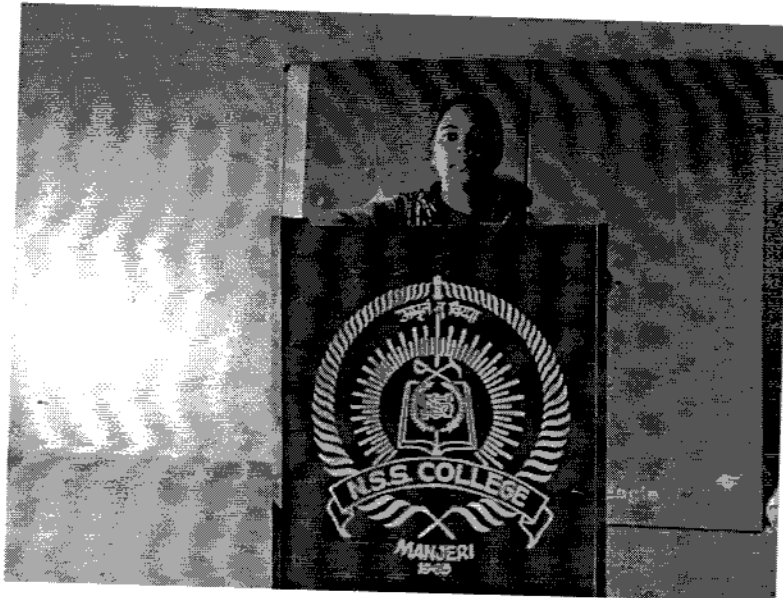
International day of abolishing slavery - December 2

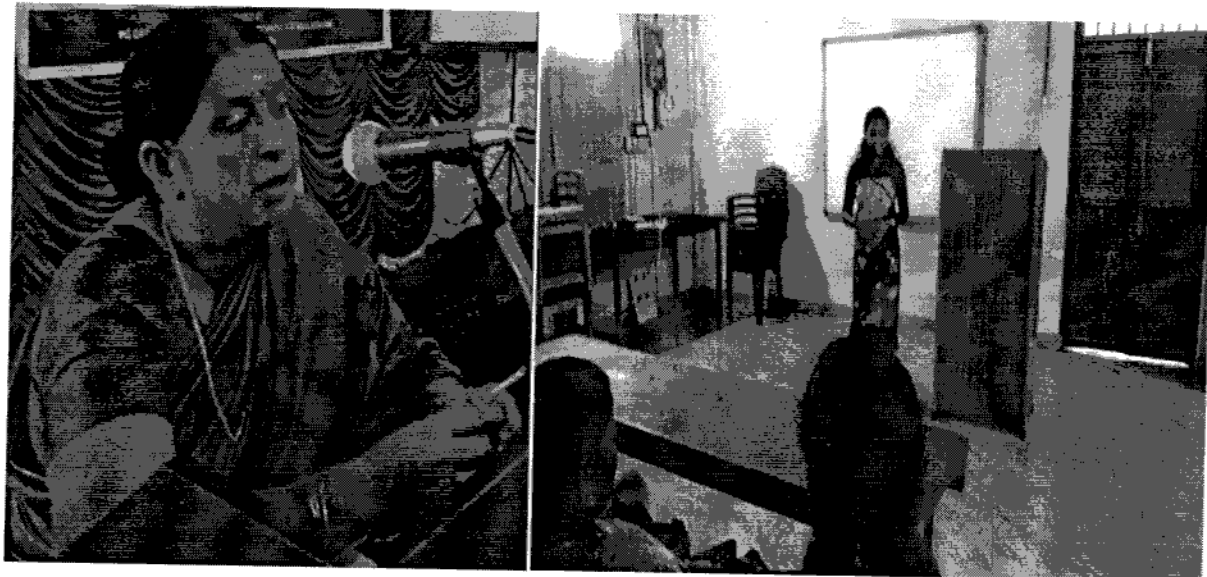
Darwin Day- February 12
